To the President of the United Nations Trusteeship Council, New York

Sir,

I have the honour to submit the following case to your high justice.

On 23 December 1956 I was arrested by members of the UPC who threatened me and took from me a sum of 5,000 francs in cash, a sheep, and six bags of fresh food; finally they took me into the bush to execute me, but I escaped and returned to the Subdivision.

I am submitting the matter to you for whatever action you think necessary.
