PROTOCOL

**BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA ON ESTABLISHING  
DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS**

WHEREAS the Governments of the Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of South Africa are desirous to develop friendly and cooperative relations between the two states in compliance with the aims and principles of the Charter of the United Nations Organization; and

WHEREAS the Governments of the Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of South Africa (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") are resolved to the maintenance of international peace and security and to the development of international cooperation;

NOTING that both the Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of South Africa are parties to the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 16 April 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to enter into diplomatic relations on the date of signature of the present Protocol; and

AGREE that missions of each of the Parties be established, initially taking into account the ability and need of each party in determining the status and modality of each party's representation.


DONE AT NICOSIA, Cyprus in the English language this tenth day of December in this Year Nineteen Hundred and Ninety Three.
