Excellency:


We have the honour to inform you that, on May 4, 1982 the Governments of the Republic of Botswana and Jamaica simultaneously published a joint communique regarding the establishment of diplomatic relations. The text reads as follows:


"The Government of the Republic of Botswana and the Government of Jamaica, desirous of developing and strengthening their relations in the interest of peace and cooperation among peoples and, on the basis of mutual respect for independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, as well as of the principles of non-interference in the internal affairs of any country, on the non-use of force in international relations, of the pacific settlement of disputes and of the other principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, have agreed to establish Diplomatic Relations between their two countries, at Ambassadorial level, as of May 4, 1982."

We have the honour, further, to request that the text of this communique be transmitted to the Permanent Missions of States Members of the United Nations.
