Prevention of exploitation of women and girls

Thailand: draft resolution

The World Conference of the International Women's Year,

Reaffirming its support for the Convention for the Suppression of the Traffic in Persons and of the Exploitation of the Prostitution of Others, adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in 1949.

Recognizing that in the <u>de facto</u> situation, the practice of prostitution and exploitation of women and young girls are still prevalent in many countries,

Concerned with the injustice and suffering imposed on involuntary prostitutes,

- 1. <u>Urges</u> Governments, in their efforts to abolish prostitution to distinguish between voluntary and involuntary prostitution, and to eliminate involuntary prostitution;
- 2. Further urges Governments to adopt measures to avert the forced recruitment of women and young girls into prostitution, and to promote the rehabilitation of prostitutes.
