WORLD PLAN OF ACTION

Madagascar, Mauritania, Niger, Rwenda and Senegal: draft resolution

International co-operation under projects designed to achieve the objectives of the World Plan of Action

The World Conference of the International Women's Year,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 3010 (XXVII) of 18 December 1972,

Bearing in mind the Programme of Concerted International Action for the Advancement of Women (1970),

<u>Recalling</u> the International Development Strategy for the Second United Nations Development Decade (1970),

Bearing in mind Economic and Social Council resolution 1850 (LVI) dated 16 May 1974 establishing the Fund for the International Women's Year,

<u>Taking note</u> of the desire expressed by many delegations to extend the Fund beyond the end of the Year,

Noting the complexity of the usual procedures with respect to assistance and international co-operation,

1. <u>Recommends</u> the simplification of the procedure governing assistance to projects designed to promote the complete integration of women into the process of development, and the implementation of such projects under the effective responsibility of national experts;

2. <u>Requests</u> the Governments concerned to take all appropriate measures to entrust the direction of such projects to the fullest possible extent to women having the requisite competence;

3. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General and the United Nations specialized agencies to draw up an adequate plan of assistence with respect to this matter, taking into account the needs and priorities of countries.
