Bahamas: draft resolution

Women and human development

The World Conference of the International Women's Year,

Recalling that the themes of the Year are Equality, Development and Peace,

Noting that the World Conference of International Women's Year will adopt a World Plan of Action for implementation by Governments and non-governmental organizations,

Aware that the agenda now focuses on woman in relation to her external reality in the areas of economics, politics and social development,

Stressing the need to take the themes of the Year a step further by relating them to woman's inner development,

Recognizing that such inner development is a potential liberating and creative force,

Requests that the World Plan of Action include and stress the need for:

- (a) Cognizance of the spiritual dimension as a prerequisite for integral human development;
- (b) Research and education in the various methods of releasing the creative force of spiritual energy for the benefit of humanity;
- (c) The establishment of centres for co-ordination, dissemination and application of such research.
