

Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the report of the Board of Auditors on the accounts of the United Nations peaceke eping operations for the financial period ended 30 June 2018 (A/73/5 (Vol. II)). During its consideration of the report, the Committee met with the members of the Board of Auditors, who provided additional information and clarification, concluding with written responses received on 19 February 2019. The Committee also met with representatives of the Secretary-General and discussed the findings of the Board in the context of the related report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the recommendations of the Board (A/73/750). The representatives provided additional information and clarification, concluding with written responses dated 19 March 2019.

The Advisory Committee recalls that the General Assembly, in its resolution 72/8 B, stated that it looked forward to considering the conclusions and recommendations of the Committee under the agenda item on financial reports and audited financial statements, and reports of the Board of Auditors, as well as under other relevant agenda items, as appropriate.

cross-cutting issues related to United Nations peacekeeping operations (A/73/755) and in its respective reports on individual peacekeeping missions.
