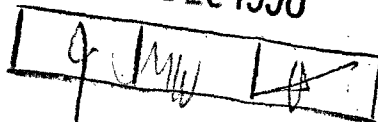

PETITION FROM THE TOGOLAND UNION
CONCERNING TOGOLAND UNDER BRITISH AND UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Note by the Secretary-General: In accordance with rule 85 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith to the members of the Trusteeship Council a communication dated 13 November 1950 from the Togoland Union which forms a second supplement to their petition of 19 October 1950 concerning the Trust Territories of Togoland under British administration and Togoland under French administration.

AUTHORITIES, PRINCIPAL POLITICAL BODIES AND ORGA-
NISATIONS AND PEOPLE OF TOGO UNDER UNITED KINGDOM
TRUSTEESHIP

RE: CONSULTATIVE COMMISSION FOR TOGO.

We have the honour to forward, herewith, the above resolutions and
beg to confirm our cable of the 4th November, 1950, which reads as follows:

"DESPITE UNANIMOUS DECISION NATURAL RULERS AND PEOPLE FOR SUSPENSION
OR DEFERRMENT CONSULTATIVE COMMISSION SCHEDULE 7TH NOVEMBER PENDING
DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS DISTRICT COMMISSIONER TREKKING PERSUADE
REPRESENTATIVES INDIVIDUALLY ATTEND."

Full report with regard to the activities of the Administering Authority will
be forwarded to you as soon as possible from which you will see that
Administering Authority has and is greatly interfering with the Consultative
Commission which is detrimental to the interests of the people.

The Congress and signatories are fully representative of all interests -
all Natural Rulers, States, Native Authorities, Togo Farmers, and Principal
Political Bodies and Organisations and peoples of Togo under United Kingdom
Trusteeship, who have hitherto been asking for the re-unification of Togo.

The Resolutions were passed, after two days meeting, by a very large
majority of eleven against one.

RE: ENLARGED CONSULTATIVE COMMISSION FOR TCGO:

Re-Unification.

HAVING taken note of the Resolution adopted by a General Meeting
at Logba on the 15 day of October, 1950.

BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby Resolved:

1. That the first meeting of the Enlarged
Consultative Commission set for the 7th
November, 1950, be deferred until the
protests and petitions already made be
fairly considered and replies received
by the various petitioners in the Trust
Territories.
