THE FOLLOWING TELEGRAM WAS SENT TODAY BY THE ACTING SECRETARY-
GENERAL, MR. DAVID OWEN TO ALL MEMBER GOVERNMENTS EXCEPT THE UNITED
STATES, REQUESTING THEM TO SUBMIT NAMES OF PROFESSIONAL MEN FOR
POSSIBLE APPOINTMENT TO THE 10 MEMBER BOARD OF DESIGN CONSULTANTS.
THE BOARD WILL ASSIST MR. WALLACE K. HARRISON, NEWLY APPOINTED
DIRECTOR OF PLANNING, IN DEVELOPING THE ARCHITECTURAL PLANS FOR THE
BUILDING OF THE UNITED NATIONS PERMANENT HEADQUARTERS IN NEW YORK
CITY.

"HAVE HONOR INVITE YOU SUBMIT YOUR GOVERNMENTS SUGGESTION OF
OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL MAN FOR POSSIBLE MEMBERSHIP ON BOARD OF
DESIGN CONSULTANTS TO ASSIST NEWLY APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF HEAD-
QUARTERS PLANNING IN DEVELOPING ARCHITECTURAL PLANS FOR PERMANENT
HEADQUARTERS AND RELATED MATTERS. FINAL APPOINTMENT WILL BE MADE
BY SECRETARY GENERAL BEFORE 1 FEBRUARY ON RECOMMENDATION DIRECTOR
HEADQUARTERS PLANNING IN CONJUNCTION WITH HEADQUARTERS ADVISORY
COMMITTEE. APPOINTMENT TEN MEMBERS ENVISAGED TO REMAIN IN NEW YORK
APPROXIMATELY FOUR MONTHS FROM 15 FEBRUARY TO 15 JUNE 1947. FOR
THIS PERIOD MEMBERS WILL BE PAID AN HONORARIUM OF FIVE THOUSAND
DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) PLUS TRAVELING EXPENSES TO NEW YORK AND RETURN.
