#### Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 45th meeting, on 26 November 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/57) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/37/L.38. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by the Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.45).

#### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/37/L.38, an additional appropriation of \$85,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
4. Statements in explanation of position were made by the representatives of Pakistan and Viet Nam.
