### Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 45th meeting, on 26 November 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/57) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/37/L.38. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by the Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.45).

#### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/37/L.38, an additional appropriation of \$85,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
- 4. Statements in explanation of position were made by the representatives of Pakistan and Viet Nam.
