PETITION FROM MR. KOFI QUARSHIE AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE DZANKU FAMILY CONCERNING TOGOLAND UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Note by the Secretary-General: In accordance with rule 85, paragraph 2, and supplementary rule F of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit to the members of the Trusteeship Council and to the Government of Italy as the Administering Authority for the Trust Territory of Somaliland, a cable dated 28 November 1952 from Mr. Kofi Quarshie and other members of the Dzanku family concerning the Trust Territory of Togoland under British administration.

This communciation is considered to be a petition raising general problems to which the attention of the Trusteeship Council has already been called and on which the Council has already taken decisions or has made recommendations.
