JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

BETWEEN

REPUBLIC OF PALAU

AND

PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH

The Republic of Palau and the People's Republic of Bangladesh,

Guided by mutual willingness to develop friendly, peace and cooperative relations in diplomatic, political, economic, humanitarian and other fields,

In accordance with principles and purpose of the United Nations Charter and the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18th April 1961;
