QUESTION OF NAMIBIA

Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Victor G. GARCIA (Philippines)

1. At its 4th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1982, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its thirty-seventh session the item entitled:

"Question of Namibia:

- "(a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
- "(b) Report of the United Nations Council for Namibia;
- "(c) Reports of the Secretary-General."

At the same meeting, the Assembly decided that the item would be considered directly in plenary meeting on the understanding that hearings of organizations concerned would be held in the Fourth Committee.

- 2. At its 3rd meeting, on 15 October, the Fourth Committee granted a request for hearing to the Reverend G. Michael Scott, International Fellowship of Reconciliation (A/C.4/37/4).
- 3. At its 19th meeting, on 11 November, the Fourth Committee heard a statement by the Reverend Scott. A summary of his statement is contained in the record of the meeting (A/C.4/37/SR.19).
