Dear Mr. President,

On behalf of the Voice of the Marshalls organization, I wish to request that members of our group be allowed to appear as petitioners before the Trusteeship Council during its forty-fifth session this year. The purpose of our appearance will be to inform the Council members of the desires of a large, substantial number of Marshallese people and leaders who wish to remain unified with their brother and sister Micronesians in the other districts under the Micronesian Constitution. 1/

We therefore ask that this petition be circulated in accordance with the appropriate rules of procedure of the Council. We will be pleased to inform you at a later date of the names of those persons who will travel to New York to appear before you and look forward to a favourable response to our request at your earliest convenience.
