REPRESENTATIVE MEETING OF KAVIENG PUBLIC INCLUDING ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY NATIVE UNANIMOUSLY DECIDED THAT FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHOULD GIVE FULL MATERIAL AND MORAL SUPPORT TO DUTCH ADMINISTRATION TO ASSIST THEM IN RESISTING INVASION OF DUTCH NEW GUINEA BY INDONESIAN FORCES STOP WE CONSIDER THE CLOSE PROXIMITY OF RECENT TROOP LANDINGS TO OUR TERRITORIES COULD JEOPARDISE OUR SECURITY THROUGH INFILTRATION OF FIFTH COLUMN COMMUNISTIC PROPAGANDA AND ACTIVITIES STOP YOUR CONSIDERATION OF POSTING MORE AUSTRALIAN TROOPS IN THIS AREA STRONGLY REQUESTED STOP - KAVIENG COMMUNITY
