We whose names appear in the attached beg leave to petition to the Mission for assistance in making possible an avenue whereby we could visit our people in the American-held Territories, in the Caroline & Marianna Island Groups.

The people we wish to visit are immediate relatives whom we have not seen for many years.

We would like to mention that some of us only want to visit, but some do want to return and stay permanently at their respective homes on those Islands.

Our Administration has always readily approved, and moreover were sympathetic to similar applications that we submitted to it in the past, but no opportunity as yet has been available to carry out our intentions.
