Occasion twelfth anniversary UNations Juvento Mondiale reiterates regards and sympathy towards all nations and organizations supporting freedom and working for peace requesting them urge Administering Authority Togoland to order general amnesty dissenting political prisoners imprisoned at time visit honourable King mission. Recent government massacres Lama-Kara peasants<sup>1/</sup> creating atmosphere terror numerous unwarranted arrests Nationalists encouraging régime emigration psychosis fear resolution 1957 recommending democratic elections universal suffrage 1958 we request Republic make arrangements for total amnesty victims so that fundamental freedoms opinion expression in accordance with Charter UNations may be reality everywhere. Universal concord.
