Briefing by the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides and Refugee Migration Monitoring in the Syrian Arab Republic (10 August 2019)

Efforts are ongoing in the Syrian Arab Republic to resolve the conflict by non-military means and provide comprehensive assistance to the Syrian people in restoring peace.

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides has not carried out any humanitarian operations in the past 24 hours.

Since the beginning of the process to reach a settlement, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides has carried out a total of 2,179 humanitarian operations. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered amounts to 3,524.96 tons.

Refugees continue to return to their pre-war abodes. The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides operates 10 checkpoints, including one airport and one maritime checkpoint, as well as a humanitarian corridor and the Julayb checkpoint.

Since 30 September 2015, a total of 578,466 people have returned to the Syrian Arab Republic from other countries and 1,303,801 internally displaced persons have returned to their pre-war abodes.

Assistance continues to be provided to rebuild infrastructure and create conditions conducive to the return of refugees. As at 9 August 2019, a total of 32,150 houses, 881 educational institutions and 191 medical centres had been rebuilt and 1,077.4 km of roads had been repaired.

Illegal armed groups active in the Idlib de-escalation area continue to violate the ceasefire regime.

On 9 August, 24 incidents of gunfire were reported. Militants of illegal armed groups fired on Khalifat, Halisah, Sukkariyah, Sabiqiyah, Binyamin, Makanis al-Duwayri, Khalidiyah and Buraykat in Aleppo Governorate; on Salma, Nahshabba, Jayqurjiq, Sirmaniyah, Karmil, Kakhbaniyah, Safsafah, Saraf and Hawash in Ladhiqiyah Governorate; and on Salihiyah in Idlib Governorate.

Terrorist groups continue to attempt to expand the area under their control by force and are concentrating armed units in the southern part of the Idlib de-escalation area.

Approximately 120 Levant Liberation Organization militants, supported by three armoured vehicles and four pickup trucks mounted with heavy machine guns, were observed moving from the area around Hish village.

Some 200 militants of the Ajnad al-Qavkaz (Soldiers of the Caucasus) terrorist group were deployed from Kafr Sajnah to the line of contact with 5 armoured vehicles, 10 pickup trucks mounted with heavy machine guns and 2 mined trucks.

In addition, the Turkistan Islamic Party deployed up to 150 terrorist militants and 13 pickup trucks equipped with mortars, multiple rocket launchers and heavy machine guns to the area around Kinaddah.

Assistance continues to be provided to rebuild infrastructure and create conditions conducive to the return of refugees. As at 10 August 2019, a total of 32,156 houses, 882 educational institutions and 191 medical centres had been rebuilt and 1,077.7 km of roads had been repaired.

Illegal armed groups active in the Idlib de-escalation area continue to violate the ceasefire regime.

On 10 August, 20 incidents of gunfire were reported. Militants of illegal armed groups fired on Sabiqiyah, Tall Jiqji and Makanis al-Duwayri in Aleppo Governorate; on Ayn al-Qantarah, Al-Asi, Bayt Janawuru, Ardash Dagh, Sanjaq, Safsafah, Qarah Jaliyah, Ayn Sulaymu, Qara Jaghiz and Araym in Ladhqiyah Governorate; on Salihiyah, Wasitah and Tall Kalbah in Idlib Governorate; and on Rubay‘ah in Hama Governorate.

Terrorist groups continue to attempt to expand the area under their control by force and are attacking Government-held positions.

On 10 August, at 6.30 p.m., up to 150 militants, supported by nine pickup trucks mounted with heavy machine-guns, attacked from the north and east in the area around Ikku;

At 7.50 p.m., up to 130 Levant Liberation Organization militants, supported by seven pickups with heavy machine guns, advanced towards Sukayk-Atshan under cover of mortar fire and balloon bombs.

On 11 August, at 4.15 a.m., up to 100 militants, supported by four pickups mounted with heavy machine guns, advanced towards Murak-Atshan;

At 6.05 a.m., up to 300 Levant Liberation Organization militants, supported by three tanks, two infantry fighting vehicles, one improvised armoured vehicle and two pickup trucks mounted with heavy machine guns, advanced towards the Kafr Ayn-Kafr Nabudah area.

All the attacks by terrorist militants were repulsed by Syrian government forces and the militants suffered heavy casualties. In repelling the attacks, 23 members of the Syrian Arab Armed Forces were killed and 7 wounded.

On 11 August 2019, from 8.04 p.m. to 8.47 p.m., air defence forces at Humaymim airbase repelled an attack by six drones launched by militants from the northeast. All six were shot down by the air defence units on duty at the airbase. No casualties or damage have been reported. The Humaymim airbase is operating as per usual.

Assistance continues to be provided to rebuild infrastructure and create conditions conducive to the return of refugees. As at 20 August 2019, a total of 32,190 houses, 885 educational institutions and 192 medical centres had been rebuilt and 1,079.3 km of roads had been repaired.

Illegal armed groups active in the Idlib de-escalation area continue to violate the ceasefire regime.

On 20 August, 27 incidents of gunfire were reported. Militants of illegal armed groups fired on Binyamin, Sabiqiyah, Makanis al-Duwayri, Aleppo and Tall Jiqji in Aleppo Governorate; on Ayn al-Qantarah, Al-Asi, Sanjaq, Sandiran, Ayn al-Asharah, Ayn Sulaymu, Safsafah, Bayt Janawuru, Qal‘at Marza, Qarah Jaliyah, Ardash Dagh and Haruf in Ladhikiyah Governorate; and on Sukkariyah in Idlib Governorate.

Briefing by the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides and Refugee Migration Monitoring in the Syrian Arab Republic (22 August 2019)

Efforts are ongoing in the Syrian Arab Republic to resolve the conflict by non-military means and provide comprehensive assistance to the Syrian people in restoring peace.

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides has carried out one humanitarian action: in Tarin, Homs Governorate, 500 food parcels weighing a total of 2.47 tons were distributed to persons in need.

Since the beginning of the process to reach a peaceful settlement, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides has carried out a total of 2,188 humanitarian operations. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered amounts to 3,548.22 tons.

Since 30 September 2015, a total of 594,929 people have returned to the Syrian Arab Republic from other countries and 1,303,833 internally displaced persons have returned to their pre-war abodes.

On 21 August, 31 incidents of gunfire were reported. Militants of illegal armed groups fired on Binyamin, Aleppo, Sabiqiyah and Halisah in Aleppo Governorate; on Ayn al-Qantarah, Saraf, Sanjaq, Jayqurjiq, Qal‘at Marza, Ardash Dagh and Karmil in Ladhikiyah Governorate; on Wasitah and Salihiyah in Idlib Governorate; and on Tall Mutawazi in Hama Governorate.

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides calls on the commanders of illegal armed groups to cease their armed provocations and move to peacefully resolve the situation in the areas under their control.

The Government of the Syrian Arab Republic has opened a humanitarian corridor and a checkpoint at Suran, Hama Governorate, to allow civilians and militants who wish to lay down their arms to leave the Idlib de-escalation area freely and without hindrance. First aid stations have been set up and drinking water, hot food, medicines and basic necessities are being made available for those leaving territory controlled by illegal armed groups, and transportation to safe areas has been arranged for them.
