PETITION FROM THE SOMALI YOUTH LEAGUE, BRANCH OF GALCAIO  
CONCERNING SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

Note by the Secretary-General: In accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rules F and L of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council, the Secretary General has the honour to transmit to the members of the Trusteeship Council, to the Government of Italy as the Administering Authority of the Trust Territory of Somaliland, and to the Governments of Colombia, Egypt, and the Philippines as members of the Advisory Council for the Trust Territory of Somaliland, two cables dated 13 and 21 June 1952 from the Somali Youth League, Branch of Galcaio, concerning the Trust Territory of Somaliland under Italian administration.

IT UNITED NATIONS ADVISORY COUNCIL MOGADISCIO  
FOR LACK OF PEACE AND SECURITY 42 SOMALIS WERE KILLED GREAT NUMBER OF PERSONS  
INJURED UNACCOUNTABLE ANIMALS WERE LOOTED NEAR DOOIEI AND BAHO IN CLASH  
BETWEEN SAAD AND SULEMAN TRIBES STOP LOCAL AUTHORITY RECOLLECTED ALL POLICE  
AND MILITARY BETWEEN THE TWO TRIBES STOP TRIBAL MUDUGH PROVINCE IS WITHOUT  
GOVERNMENT AND WILL SHORTLY BE WITHOUT POPULATION STOP WE APPEAL TO UNITED  
NATIONS FOR RAPID ACTION.

UNITED NATIONS ADVISORY COUNCIL MOGADISHU

REFERENCE OUR TELEGRAMMS OF 10TH 12TH JUNE 1952<sup>1/</sup> REFERS STOP 19 SOMALIS  
WERE KILLED 20 SERIOUSLY WOUNDED 21 SLIGHTLY INJURED GREAT NUMBER OF ANIMALS  
LOOTED NEAR AMARA MUDUGH PROVINCE IN FURTHER CLASH BETWEEN SAAD AND SUEIMA STOP  
OTHER DEATHS WERE MENTIONED BUT NOT YET CONFIRMED STOP NO SIGNAL CRIMINALS WAS  
ARRESTED STOP ALL WOUNDED PERSONS ARE STILL IN BUSH AND NO MEDICAL INTEREST WERE  
GIVEN STOP TRIBAL REINFORCEMENT ARE INCREASING STOP WE INFORM YOU THE PRESENT  
LOCAL AUTHORITY SO NOT WANT TO ENFORCE PEACE AND SECURITY STOP WE ASK UNITED  
NATIONS TO INTEREST FOR PEACE AND SECURITY OF MUDUGH STOP IN A SHORT PERIOD THIS  
PROVINCE WILL BE WITHOUT POPULATION STOP WE FARTHER ASK SUCH DEATHS BE PUBLISHED  
IN WORLD PRESS STOP WE BEG TO REMAIN YOU HUMAN RIGHTS STOP LETTER FOLLOWS.
