PETITION FROM MR. NUR ALASSO ASSIR CONCERNING  
SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

Note by the Secretary-General: In accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rules F and L of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit to the members of the Trusteeship Council, to the Government of Italy as the Administering Authority of the Trust Territory of Somaliland, and to the Governments of Colombia, Egypt, and the Philippines as members of the Advisory Council for the Trust Territory of Somaliland, a communication dated 1 October 1952 from Mr. Nur Alasso Assir concerning the Trust Territory of Somaliland under Italian administration.

This communication was transmitted to the Secretary-General by the United Nations Advisory Council for the Trust Territory of Somaliland under Italian administration, and forms a supplement to the petition set forth in document T/PET.11/255.

Sir,

I the undersigned, NUR ALASSO ASSIR tribe Murosada subtribe Sebdi living in Mogadiscio at Bondere, have the honour to state that I was Somali Police Agent No. 1600 from 3/10/49 and had carried out my duty eagerly and honestly, when I was enlisted in the Somali Police Force I was healthy and strong, while I was in the service I fell ill and have been found to be affected of paralysis, my legs are crippled, on 15th February 1952 I have been discharged from the service as declared physically unfit, on 18th same February I submitted petition to the Police Commanding High Officer stating that the disability had caught me while I was in the service and asked what I was entitled but yet I have received no reply, on 28th same February I submitted petition to the Somalia Administrator on the same subject but also I have not received any reply, the crippling of my legs has caught me while I was under the Police Force service.

Now therefore I have the honour to apply for your kind intervention either to get me paid a lump sum of what I am entitled or to get pensioned on account of the disability by me suffered.
