PETITION FROM MR. ABSCIR ALI UEIRAH CONCERNING SOMALIIAND UNDER TRAITAN ADMINISTRATION

(Circulated in accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rules F and L of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council)

To the Secretary-General United Nation Org., New York, U.S.A.

Gelkayu, Somalia, 28th Oct., 55.

Sir,

I have received your kind acknowledgement of the petition I have sent to the U.N.O. on 25th August, 54, and noted with satisfaction that you have circulated it to the members of Trusteeship Council of the United Nations Org. who will examine the Petition in the Session of Jan. 56, when I hope the Council will put into view the hiden right for which I have cried to the United Nations Org.

I must add right here that:

While my request respective to the ground now in question had first dated in 1947, and I was writing almost twice in each year between the interval of eight years (i.e. from 47 to now) and that I had spent innumerable sum of money in writing to P/N., to the Authority, and in travelling from Galkayu to Belet Uen and Mogadishu, Sig. Forobollini, and Italian, born in Italy and, perhaps in Italy in 47 when I first made out my petition to British authority in Somalia and who came in Galkayu in 1953, and wrote his first petition for this ground in 54, has much more hope to erect the ground to day because of mere supperiority of his race and because of the popularity of his Nationality.
