ADMINISTRATOR SOMALILAND MOG/SYL MOG/ADVISORY COUNCIL MOG/ UNDERSIGNED
SOLEMAN TRIBE WERE UNJUSTLY CONDEMNED TO PAY DIAH IN RESPECT OF
2 PERSONS, 4 MEMBERS OF TRIBE WHO APPEALED HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED PROPER
REPLY AND TODAY CHIEF REGIONAL OFFICER SUDDENLY SEIZED ABOUT 400 CAMELS
STOP AS OUR TRIBE HAS TWICE SUFFERED AT HANDS OF SAAD WE REQUEST ADMINISTRATION
NOT TO CAUSE BLOCODY CONFLICT BETWEEN TWO BROTHERLY TRIBES BY FAILING TO
PROVIDE NECESSARY JUSTICE CALLED FOR AND TO PUT AN END TO FAVOURED TREATMENT
OF ONE TRIBE WHICH IS RUIN OF THE TERRITORY AND PEOPLE OF SOMALILAND WE
REQUEST RETURN OF THE CAMELS AND EXPECT JUSTICE STOP WE AWAIT REPLY AND HAVE
HONOUR ETC.
