PETITION FROM MR. MUSTAFA MURSCHID ALBEK CONCERNING
SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

Mogadiscio, 7-9-56

To the Head Office of the U.N.O.

I, the undersigned, Mustafa Murscid Albek. In 1952 I sent a request
to your Head Office and you sent it to New York. ^{1/} From there they replied
with a vote of ten persons, except the other two. As a matter of fact,
Doctor Benardelli has declared that he would grant me everything that I
might need. From that time onwards he gave me something twice, the first
time in 52, the second time in 56. In fact, his promise was, anytime.
And at present I went away without receiving anything. And I am unemployed.
In my house I have four sons and their mother. It is unfair of them to leave
me unemployed, since my later father died while accomplishing his duty. I also
informed (of my situation) the District Commissioner Zuccardi who gave me a
letter for Accountant Santosilia without giving me any employment although he
had plenty of employment.
