Compliments

We the inhabitants of Nagalia wish to bring the following to your kind  
notice.

(1) We have been without a Resident for a long time and we hope that you will  
appoint a just person as our Resident.

(2) The airplane which carries the mail has not landed in our territory for  
some time. The landing of this plane was most useful to our area and its  
progress. We now have two sick persons who are of importance in our area. They  
could have received treatment, had the plane continued to land in our territory.

(3) We need a white doctor who is qualified and efficient. Without such a doctor  
we cannot live happily. Such a doctor could have cured the two useful men above-  
mentioned and others suffering from malaria or other fevers.

(4) The workers digging wells have arrived in our place. They are in need of  
more workers to help them and they require at the same time a motor pump to lift  
the water to the top. This is very important. We had formerly asked government  
to dig wells for us at different places but we had no satisfactory reply.
