PETITION FROM MR. AHMED MOHAMED AFRAH AND OTHERS CONCERNING SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

(Circulated in accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rule L of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council)

Mogadiscio, 7 January 1956.

In submitting this petition we, the undersigned, wish to bring the following facts to your attention:

Last November four political <u>shir</u> were held of the <u>rer</u> Eli Omar, Iacub, Abdalla UarsangheliandOmar Uarsangheli of the Abgal tribe living in the Itala district. The main purpose of the political <u>shir</u> was to choose electoral representatives and deputy representatives. The <u>shir</u> were held in conformity with the regulations in force and were supervised by the Supervisory Committee and the District Commissioner of Itala in the usual manner.

About 32,200 electors took part in the <u>shir</u> and elected four of our people as their electoral representatives, namely: Ahmed Mohamed Afrah, Uarsama Abdi Ali, Sheikh Abdullahi Toho Mohamed and Sheikh Ahmed Diso Nur. The four others: Mohamud Hassan Gaal, Sheikh Mohamed Alasso Sare, Abukar Mohamed Ahmed and Buled Ahmed Subie were elected deputy electoral representatives. The Supervisory Committee and the District Commissioner both confirmed that the <u>shir</u> were valid. Towards the end of November, each of us received through the District Office a T/PET.11/669 English Page 2

certificate signed by the Regional Judge of Benadir, Dr. Luigi Santanielo, reconfirming that the <u>shir</u> were valid and recognizing our status as the electoral representatives and deputy representatives of the above-mentioned four rer.

The District Commissioner of Itala later informed us that the central authority had declared all four <u>shir</u> to be null and void. We immediately protested to the competent authority against the decision which we considered unjust and arbitrary. Our efforts to ascertain the reason for the declaration that the <u>shir</u> were null and void have so far been fruitless. Our attempts to obtain permission from the district, regional and central authorities to convene new <u>shir</u>, even though that would entail further demands on our resources have also been fruitless. Our <u>rer</u> incurred enormous expenditure in organizing and convening the four <u>shir</u> that were delcared null and void.

We respectfully ask you to consider these facts in examining our petition. We also ask you to consider the fact that 32,200 tribal electors have been deprived of their right to participate, even indirectly, in the forthcoming political elections.
