Sir,

I the undersigned Ali Nur Abdi Somali age 64, born at Galcaio, have the honour to submit this application for your kind consideration, to laid dawn; the great protest against the present Italian administration.

The last decision of the U.N.T.C. $\frac{1}{}$ were that I should present my case before a court of law, I have do so, the president of the Court asked me to produce witnesses, I have brought 4 witnesses called

(1) MOHAMED ABDULLA AHMED aged 58

(2) MIRE ALI OMAR age 49

(3) HUSSEN ALI ABDULLE age 44

(4) ALI MOHAMED UARSAMA age 55.

All these people are living in Mogadiscio, and they gave a true evidence, after and oath, but the court did not considered their evidence, and I have been told if I don't be quiet, I'll be sentenced to jail. I shall like to have the justice from the U.N.T.C.

Hoping to receive your earliest reply.
