PETITION FROM EX-SOLDIERS OF DINSOR CONCERNING SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

SOMALILAND

Communication from a group of ex-servicemen

28 September 1954

To the members of the Visiting Mission now in the village of Dinsor.

We are complaining against Italy, because from 1933 until 1941 we were soldiers, and then it abandoned us in Tershin.

The British captured us and took away our rifles and uniform. We have no papers or legal documents. Now, if you are just people, we ask for our rights; and if you are protectors of the oppressed, protect us with our justice. We beg for an answer before you go back.
