During the month of July while in Mogadiscio on private matters I was told by the Commissioner that I was urgently called by the Commissioner of Baidoa Stop I left immediately for Baidoa where I was met by the Commissioner Stop The latter said it was not true that he had called me but he had received a telegram from the Minister of the Interior Mogadiscio to prepare for suspension of salary of District Counsellor but not to be troubled because member of opposite party Stop. On 16 August I asked the District Commissioner for permission to leave Baidoa to repair my automobile in Mogadiscio Stop This officer assured me I could not leave until further orders so I remained until today for unknown reasons Stop I wish to know through you what are the rules that forbid me to travel through Somalia if I am not a prisoner since I am no more a Counsellor Stop I am waiting to receive an answer as soon as possible urgent Stop
