The General Assembly, recognizing the offer of the Government of Barbados to host the fifteenth session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development and the offer of the Government of the United Arab Emirates to host the World Investment Forum and an electronic commerce week for Asia, takes note of the report of the Trade and Development Board on its sixty-sixth session,¹ which was held in Geneva from 24 to 27 June 2019, and the decision contained therein, and welcomes the generous offer of the Government of Barbados to host the fifteenth session of the Conference.
