A number of us here at Maryknoll, New York, have been following the explosive situation on the island of Belau as non-governmental organization members and as a religious order and congregation working in the Pacific Islands.

We are deeply disturbed by the apparently illegal vote that was held in August of 1987 in which Belauans were apparently intimidated to rescind their nuclear-free Constitution. We are writing you today to ask that the United Nations Charter ensure Belau's self-determination.

Please share with us the latest developments concerning this issue and what actions the United Nations Trusteeship Council will be taking on this concern of ours.
