FIFTH PALAU LEGISLATURE

FOURTH REGULAR SESSION, APRIL 1973

RESOLUTION NO. 73(1)-26

Requesting the President of the United States of America and the United States Civil Aeronautics Board to take into account the desires and wishes of the people of Micronesia in awarding the route between Japan and Saipan.

WHEREAS, the United States Civil Aeronautics Board is currently considering the Service to Saipan Case (Dock 24421) for its recommendation and approval by the President of the United States; and

WHEREAS, several airlines, including Pan American World Airways, Northwest Orient, and Continental Airlines have submitted proposals to serve the route between Japan and Saipan; and

WHEREAS, only Continental Airlines has proposed to extend its services beyond Saipan to the rest of Micronesia, including Palau District; and

WHEREAS, in the case of Palau District the proposal of Continental Airlines offers such economic benefits as increased tourism and employment, lower passenger and freight rates between Japan and Koror, and six flights during a week from Tokyo and Osaka to Koror and two flights during a week from Truk to Koror; and

WHEREAS, because of the benefits to be derived by the entire Trust Territory, the Congress of Micronesia and various legislative bodies and organizations have endorsed Continental Airlines for the route between Japan and Saipan; and

WHEREAS, the Fifth Palau Legislature adopted during its First Regular Session, October 1971, resolution No. 71(2)-16, which states that "the President of the United States and the Civil Aeronautics Board be and are hereby requested to grant Continental/Air Micronesia routes from Palau to Japan and other Far Eastern Countries"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Palau Legislature, Fourth Regular Session, April 1973 that the President of the United States and the United States Civil Aeronautics Board are hereby requested to take into account the desires and wishes of the people of Micronesia in awarding the route between Japan and Saipan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President and the Civil Aeronautics Board hereby respectfully requested to award the route between Japan and Saipan to Continental Airlines; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States, the United States Civil Aeronautics Board, both the Senate Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs and

the House Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs of the United States Congress, the President of the United Nations Security Council, the President of the United Nations Trusteeship Council, the High Commissioner, the members of the state delegation of Hawaii to the Congress of the United States and Continental Airlines.
