REGARDING THE EVENTS IN THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION RESOLUTION

The undersigned Cameroonian students at the University of Caen, having been informed of the latest events in the Cameroons under British administration and being met in special assembly:

- 1. Express their indignation at the fact that the fundamental human freedoms are no longer in the least respected in the Cameroons;
- 2. Request the Administering Authorities of both zones of the Cameroons to grant a complete amnesty to all political prisoners, as this is the only measure capable of restoring the peace and order which they desire for their country;
- 3. Re-affirm their desire for the Re-unification and Independence of the Cameroons.
