Dear Mr. Murray:

In regard to our people's latest manifestation of their perpetual desire for self-determination, we are enclosing a complete report 1/ on the popular referendum held in Palau on 24 September 1976.

The populace of Palau has delivered a powerful and responsible mandate to its leadership to seek separate negotiations from the rest of Micronesia with the United States of America. We have high expectations that all the nations of the world community will realize that on 24 September a dynamic determination of our people's wishes, hopes and aspirations were voiced in this historical event.
