CONSIDERATIONS OF THE REPORTS CONCERNING PREFARATION ACTIVITIES FOR THE CONFERENCE

Belgium: Draft decision

Timetable for the proparation for the Conference

The Preparatory Committee for the United Mations Conference on New and Renewable Sources of Energy,

<u>Urges</u> the Secretary General to adjust the timetable, as proposed in annex III of document 4/35/321, in order to allow the following results to be achieved:

- (a) Final reports of the technical panels and the Secretariat's synthesis report on the work of these panels should be ready and circulated to Governments and other groups involved in the preparatory work, including the <u>ad hoc</u> expert groups before they meet, not later than 15 December 1980; to this end, the Preparatory Committee recommends that any comments, other than those already given at its second session, to the content of interim reports, (document A/CONF.100/PC/5 to 12, 17, 21 and 22) be submitted to the Secretary General not later than 15 September 1980.
- (b) Final reports of the ad hoc expert groups should be ready and circulated to Governments and other groups involved in the preparatory work not later than 15 February 1981.

- (c) The final report of the joint meeting of the Chairmen of the technical panels and of eminent experts and scientists should be ready and circulated to Governments and other bodies involved in the preparatory work not later than 15 March 1981.
- reports mentioned above under (a), (b) and (c) as well as outline suitable recommendations for consideration of the Conference should be ready and circulated to Governments not later than 15 April 1981.
