JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF SURINAME AND THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

The Government of the Republic of Suriname and the Government of the Republic of Botswana,

Being desirous of strengthening the friendly relations existing between our two countries and peoples and promoting mutually beneficial co-operation and on the basis of mutual respect and the principles of sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of other states,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué,

In witness thereof, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the Joint Communiqué in two original texts in the English language, both copies being equally authentic.
