JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE

ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MALDIVES AND TUVALU

The Government of the Republic of Maldives and the Government of Tuvalu, guided by the principles enunciated in the Charter of the United Nations being desirous of developing and strengthening relations of friendship and mutually beneficial cooperation, have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at Ambassadorial level, as of the day of the signing of this Communiqué.

The relations between the two States will be based on the principles of sovereign equality among states, mutual respect, self-determination, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of each other.
