XVII. Relations with Other Organizations.

1. The Organization shall be brought into relationship with the United Nations as one of the specialized agencies referred to in Article 57 of the Charter of the United Nations. The agreement or agreements bringing the Organization into relationship with the United Nations shall be subject to approval by a two-thirds vote of the Assembly of the Organization.
2. The Organization shall establish effective relationships and co-operate closely with such other inter-governmental organizations as may be desirable. Any formal agreement entered into with such organizations shall be subject to approval by a two-thirds vote of the Assembly.
3. The Organization may, on matters within its competence, make suitable arrangements for consultation and co-operation with non-governmental international organizations, and, with the consent of the State concerned, with national or other organizations.
4. Subject to the approval of two-thirds of the Assembly, the Organization may, in respect of any other international organization or agency whose purposes and activities lie within its field of competence, take over such of the functions, resources, and obligations of any such organization or agency as may be conferred upon the Organization by international agreement, or as may be conferred upon the Organization through mutually acceptable arrangements entered into between the competent authorities of the respective organizations.
