## JOINT COMMUNIQUE

The Government of the Republic of Kenya and the Government of Malta, desirous to strengthen the bonds of friendship and cooperation between their two countries in the political, economic and cultural fields, based on the principles of mutual respect for territorial integrity and non intervention in internal affairs of each other, as well as norms of international law and the principles of the United Nations Charter, have, through exchange of Notes established diplomatic relations, at the ambassadorial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, of 18<sup>th</sup> April 1961. The Agreement entered into force with effect upon exchange of Notes on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2004.

The Government of Malta and the Government of the Republic of Kenya express their assurance that the establishment of diplomatic relations responds to the national interest of both States and will consolidate the strengthening of international peace and cooperation.
