AGREEMENT ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF SAINT LUCIA AND THE FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ETHIOPIA

The Government of Saint Lucia and the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia;

Interested in developing relations between the two countries and their peoples on the basis of equality, sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in each other's internal affairs;

Committed to strengthening friendly relations between the two countries and developing bilateral cooperation in different fields of mutual concern;

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961;

Have Agreed to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Agreement.

In Witness thereof, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries, being duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement in two originals in the English language.
