PROTOCOL

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN GEORGIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF MONTENEGRO

Georgia and the Republic of Montenegro, later referred as Parties, guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two countries in political, economic and cultural fields have decided to establish diplomatic relations.

Parties have agreed to develop their relations in accordance with the United Nations Charter on the basis of the principles of equality between states, mutual respect, independence and sovereignty, non-interference into internal affairs of each other.

Parties are convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between Georgia and the Republic of Montenegro corresponds to the interests of the both States, is not directed against any other country and will facilitate the strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace.

Parties have agreed to base their diplomatic relations on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, signed on April 18th, 1961.

The protocol is in force upon the signature.

Done in New York on October 29TH 2007, in English and Georgian languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation of the protocol English text will prevail.
