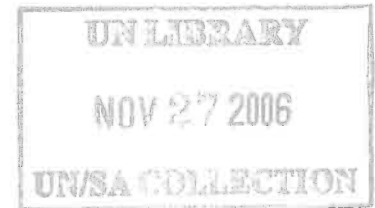

**JOINT COMMUNIQUE  
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN  
THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF GUYANA**

The Government of the Republic of Croatia and the Government of the Republic of Guyana, desirous to promote and strengthen relations of friendship and cooperation between the two countries, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic relations of 1961.

In establishing diplomatic relations, the two countries reiterate their adherence to the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

Diplomatic relations shall be established on the date of exchange of diplomatic notes through which the two countries will inform each other that the internal procedures for entry into force of this Communiqué have been completed.

Done at Kuala Lumpur on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2003, in two copies in the English language, both texts being equally authentic.
