Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017. The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported eight violations in the following Governorates: five in Aleppo, two in Qunaytirah and one in Ladhqiyyah.

The Turkish representative office has reported four incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: two in Damascus, one in Hama and one in Idlib.

Most incidents of small arms being fired indiscriminately have been reported in areas controlled by fighters of the Nusrah Front terrorist group.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out one humanitarian operation (delivery of food) in Zabadani, Damascus Governorate, with a total cargo weight of 2.1 tons.

In total, 1,709 humanitarian operations have been carried out, with a total cargo weight of 2,356 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 77 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 66,931 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, one ceasefire regime agreement has been signed with Abu al-Hus in Aleppo Governorate.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process has increased to 2,313.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah Governorates.
