## Page 17, paragraph 2

This paragraph should read as follows:

"Dr. FORREST (WHO) asked for a elarification of the position. Since it appeared that the UNRRA Fund had already been allocated for specific activities sanctioned by the Joint Committee, such as the BCG vaccination research programme, and that WHO did not have funds to cover the cost of the seven posts mentioned, it seemed that it would not be possible to carry out the programmes which the Executive Board had approved, as the technical officers necessary would not be available. So far as he could see, that meant the postponement of at least some part of those programmes."
