ENRIQUE IGLESIAS DESIGNATED AS ENERGY ADVISER TO DIRECTOR-GENERAL

FOR DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION

Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar today announced that he has designated Enrique V. Iglesias, Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Latin America (ECLA), to be a Special Adviser on new and renewable sources of energy to the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation.

In addition to his responsibilities as Executive Secretary of ECLA, Mr. Iglesias served as Secretary-General of the 1981 United Nations Conference on New and Renewable Sources of Energy and, more recently, as Chairman of the <u>ad hoc</u> working group of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination (ACC) on follow-up to the Nairobi Programme of Action for the development and utilization of new and renewable sources of energy.
