ENRIQUE IGLESIAS DESIGNATED AS ENERGY ADVISER TO DIRECTOR-GENERAL
FOR DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION

Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar today announced that he has designated Enrique V. Iglesias, Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Latin America (ECLA), to be a Special Adviser on new and renewable sources of energy to the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation.

In addition to his responsibilities as Executive Secretary of ECLA, Mr. Iglesias served as Secretary-General of the 1981 United Nations Conference on New and Renewable Sources of Energy and, more recently, as Chairman of the ad hoc working group of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination (ACC) on follow-up to the Nairobi Programme of Action for the development and utilization of new and renewable sources of energy.
