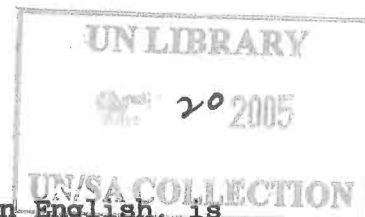

Excellency,



The Government of the Republic of Hungary and the Government of Saint Lucia,

Guided by their mutual willingness to develop and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two States in political, economic, social, humanitarian and other fields, in accordance with the principles and norms enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, International Law and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961,


Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

The Government of the Republic of Hungary and the Government of Saint Lucia wish to express their mutual confidence that establishing diplomatic relations correspond to the interests of both States and will help to consolidate international peace and security as well as peaceful co-existence.




