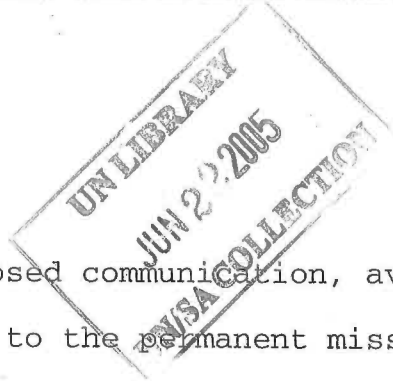



Excellency,



The Parties to this agreement agree that their diplomatic relations will be founded on the principles and norms enshrined of the Charter of the United Nations and international law.



The two Parties agree that their diplomatic relations shall be guided by the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961,






