Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following text communicated by the Government of Sweden.

ROYAL ORDER

amending Article 1 of the Order of 16 September 1933 (No. 559) containing certain regulations regarding narcotic substances and preparations;

Given at the Palace, Stockholm, 9 April 1948.

We, Gustaf Adolf, have been pleased to direct that Article 1 of the Order of 16 September 1933 containing certain regulations regarding narcotic substances and preparations* be amended as follows:

1.

The present Order relates to

- A. 1. *raw opium*, in the trade;
10. (a) *1-methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester* and its salts, such as dolantin, dolantol, demerol and pethidine;
11. *preparations* consisting of morphine or salts of morphine or of cocaine or salts of cocaine, in solution or diluted in a neutral substance, whether fluid or solid, irrespective of the cocaine or morphine content of the preparation; other *preparations* containing more than 0.2 per cent morphine or 0.1 per cent cocaine, except the preparation *Pilulae terpini opiatae* of the Swedish Pharmacopoeia, 1946;
12. *preparations* containing diacetylmorphine or other morphine esters or ecgonine esters, other than cocaine, or their salts; *preparations* containing any of the substances enumerated in subparagraphs 8, 9 and 10, *except*
(a) cardiazol dicodid solution containing not less than 10 per cent cardiazol and not more than 0.5 per cent dihydrocodeinone salt, and
(b) *preparations* of ethylmorphine, methylmorphine (codeine) or their salts containing, in the case of *preparations* in solid form such as tablets, lozenges, etc., not more than 0.1 grammes of the narcotic substance in each tablet, lozenge, etc., or, in the case of *preparations* in fluid form, not more than 10 per cent;
13. *galenical preparations* not completely pure.

This Order shall enter into force on 1 July 1948.
