COMPARISON OF PLANS SUBMITTED BY
DR. CAVAILLON AND DR. LECLAINCHE, SIR WILSON JAMESON, DR. PARRAN
AND DR. STAMPAR

Establishment

The four plans propose the establishment of a single international health organization, all but Sir Wilson Jameson's mentioning a Specialized Agency. Sir Wilson Jameson's plan specifically proposes the absorption of the League Health Organization, the Office International d'Hygiène, the Pan American Sanitary Bureau and the Health Division of UNRRA. Dr. Stampar's plan specifically provides for the merger in the new organization, of the "Office" and the Health Organization of the League, and the assumption of the health duties of UNRRA's Health Division.

Purposes

All four plans set as their aims:

1. the raising of standards of living,
2. the freedom, wellbeing, and happiness of individuals,
3. the increase of understanding among the peoples of the world,
4. the furtherance of the attainment of peace.

In the plans submitted by Dr. Cavailon and Dr. Leclainche and by Dr. Stampar, these objects are elaborated in the preamble, whereas in those by Sir Wilson Jameson and Dr. Parran they are more briefly mentioned and covered also by reference to the aims listed in the Charter of the United Nations.

Functions

The similarity in the functions to be performed by the Organization according to the four plans is indicated by the table below. There are

differences, such as the proposal in Dr. Parran's plan to have the Organization develop the establishment and promote standardization, whereas in Dr. Cavaillon's plan the Organization would merely study the setting up of standards. Dr. Stampar's plan indicates the functions in rather general terms, the Organization performing such functions as are necessary to carry out the purposes set forth in the preamble, whereas in the other plans the functions are more specifically listed.
